Poster Contest Guidelines

- 1) Posters must contain the TESL Ontario emblem seen above as well as *ESL Week 2008, November 9-15 2008*.

The theme of this year's conference is 'Celebrating the International Year of Languages' which has been officially recognized by UNESCO on their website as an 'International Year of the Languages' project.

- 2) This poster should be a representation of the diversity of ESL learners across Ontario.
- 3) The contest is open to any elementary or secondary ELLs and ESL/LINC adult learners in Ontario.
- 4) The poster design should be on letter-sized paper (8 ½ x 11 inches). The poster being submitted to TESL Ontario may be in colour, but a black and white copy must be submitted as well.
- 5) Only ONE poster can be submitted from each school/centre. Please coordinate efforts to select one entry amongst classes/teachers. ESL learners are welcome to work on the poster with help from their teachers and classmates. The final poster can be entered by an individual artist or group of artists.
- 6) The grand prize winner will receive \$300 and there will be three runner-up prizes of \$100 each.
- 7) The extended deadline for submission of posters is May 31st, 2008. The winners will be contacted by June 15. To enter, fill out the attached *Poster Contest 2008 Entry Form* and send entries to:
