AFTER YOU GRADUATE

Once you graduate, if you meet the degree and English language proficiency requirements, you are able to apply for the TESL Ontario Certificate of Accreditation and professional designation.

You will be charged, a one-time application fee of \$125+HST and a pro-rated accreditation fee (maximum of \$82+HST).

The annual renewal fee for accredited membership to maintain your certificate of accreditation is \$160+HST.

PROFESSIONAL DESIGNATION

Once you are approved for your Certificate of Accreditation, you will be entitled to use the professional designation OCELT (Ontario Certified English Language Teacher).
