

CTESOL Program Accreditation Annual Renewal

The TESL Ontario accreditation of a CTESOL program is for a period of 12 months from the accreditation approval date, after which continued TESL Ontario accreditation is contingent on the accredited training provider's submitting an annual report and paying the annual renewal fee on or before the specified due date.

If the required annual report and fee are not received on or before the due date, the TESL program accreditation expires on the expiry date shown on the Certificate of Accreditation, and the training provider's information is taken off the TESL Ontario website on the same date. To regain accreditation, the training provider will be required to submit a new application package and pay all applicable fees.

Should accreditation be granted to a CTESOL program, any subsequent changes including, but not limited to, changes in address/location, ownership, staff, staff assignments, curriculum, facilities, and practicum locations, must be forwarded to TESL Ontario for review and approval 30 business days in advance of any changes. Failure to do so may result in the TESL Ontario accreditation being revoked.
